The District Evaluation Advisory Committee (DEAC) has adopted the Marzano School Leadership Evaluation Model as the framework for the Irvington Public Schools' Principal Evaluation Tool.

The Marzano's School Leadership Evaluation model is designed to correspond to the teacher evaluation framework to maximize impact on raising student achievement. It provides principals and administrators with strategies and tools to empower teachers, so leaders and teachers can focus together on the ultimate objective: improving student learning.

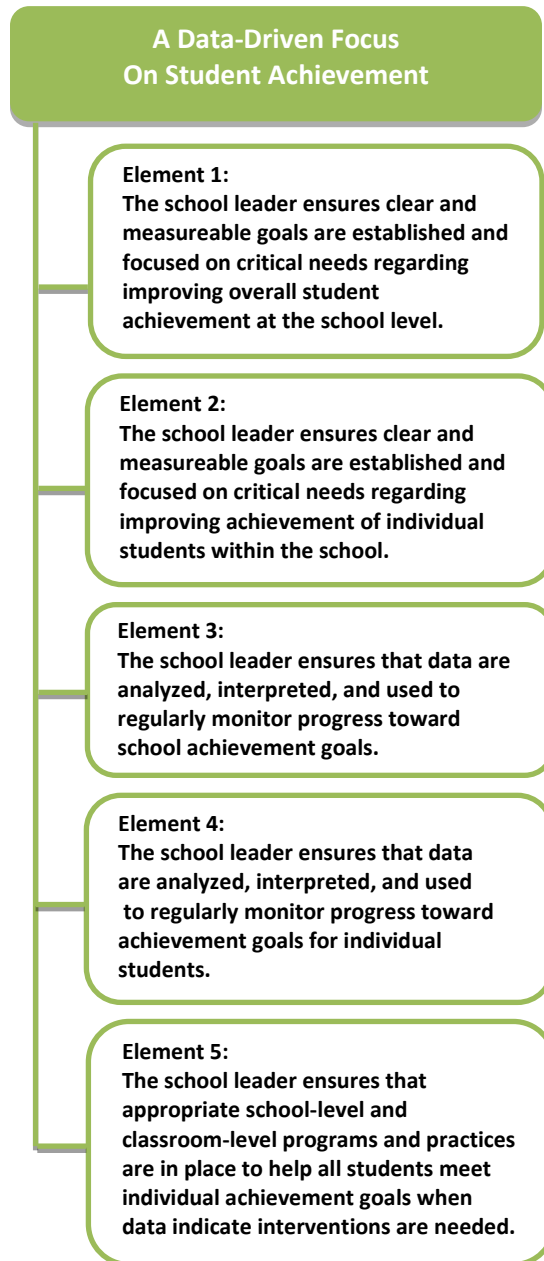
Key Features of the Marzano School Leadership Evaluation Model:

- The model contains five domains with 24 strategies related to successful leadership with targeted professional development.
- The model provides clear evidences to help school administrators evaluate school leaders fairly and reliably.

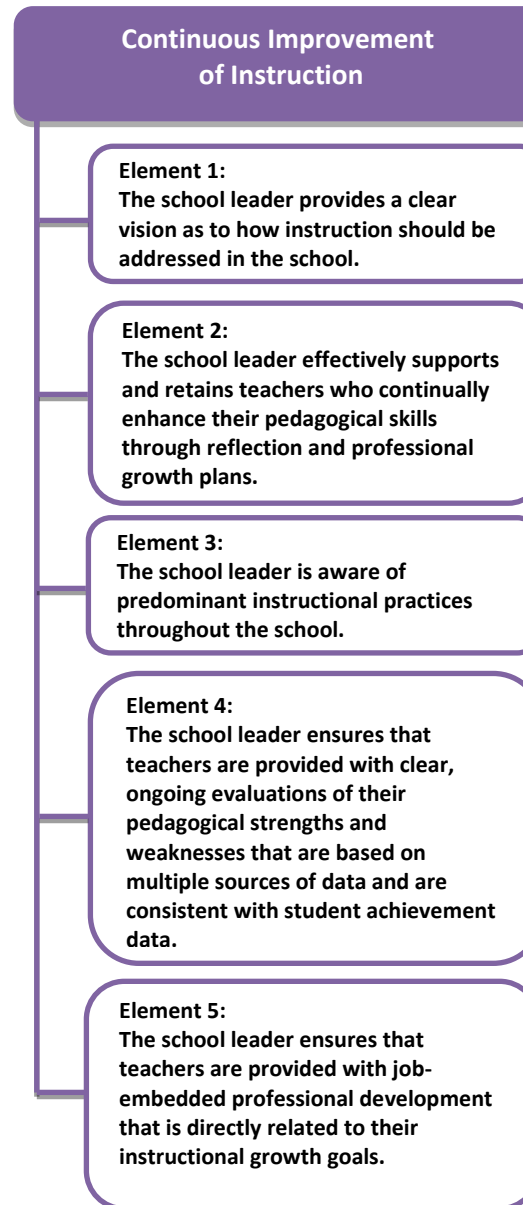

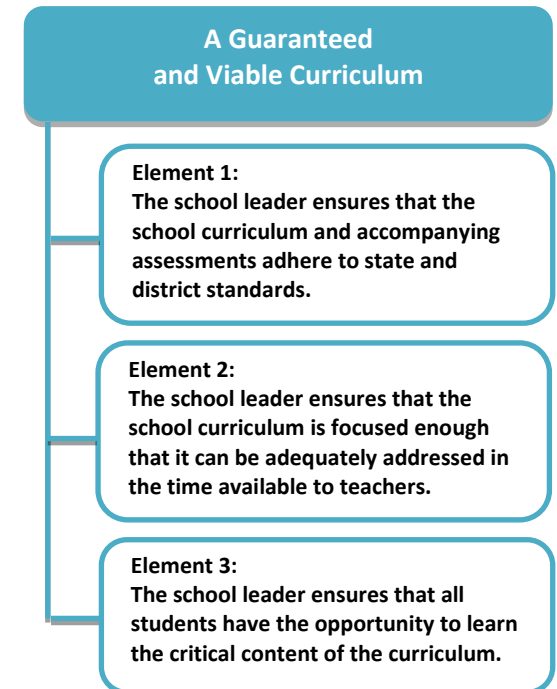

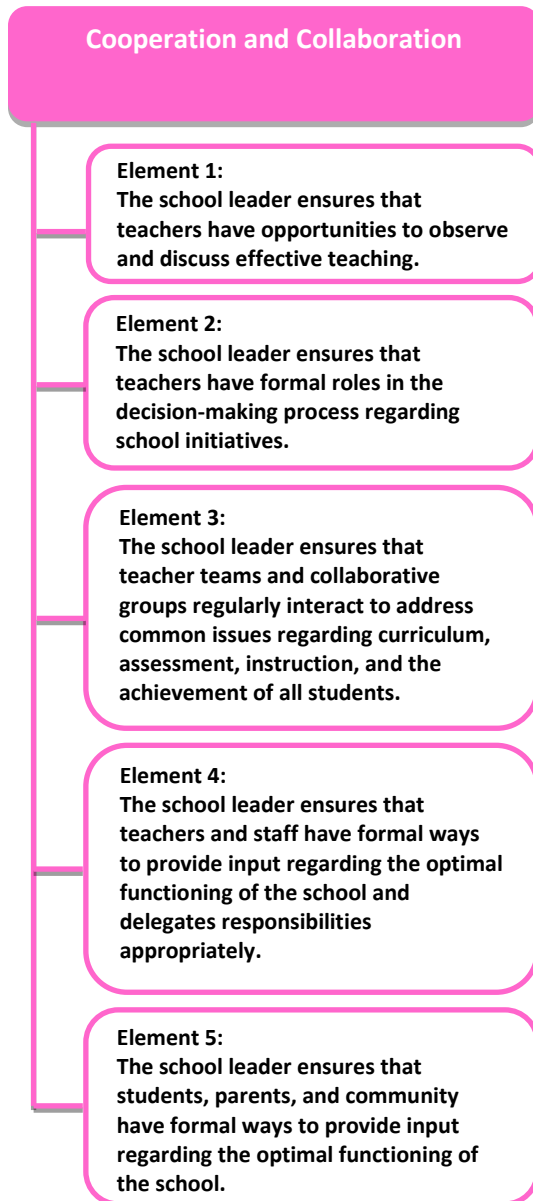
