- 28 Current sanitation certificates must be posted in a prominent location at each school. Two sanitation inspections per school year are required. If two inspections have not been conducted, a letter to the local health department requesting the second inspection must be on file.
- 29 Sanitation certificates from the prior school year must be available, upon request, to the reviewer
- 30 ___ A completed copy of a Hazard Analysis Critical Control Point (HACCP) Food Safety Plan based on Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) must be available at each school serving meals.
- 31 ___ Completed HACCP process charts and time/temperature logs OR daily production records that contain cooking processes and time/temperatures.
- 32 ___ Completed temperature logs for refrigerators, freezers and milk coolers. Can use Daily Freezer & Refrigerator Temperature Log (Form 363)

Civil Rights

- 33 Completed Civil Rights Compliance Form (Form 86) for each school under the LEA.
- 34 USDA approved "And Justice for All" poster must be predominately displayed in each cafeteria/classroom.
- 35 ___ Documentation of required civil rights training for staff and supervisors involved in eligibility determinations and food service. Documentation includes date of training, topics covered and attendee names.
- 36 Written procedures for receiving and processing civil rights complaints regarding the food service program.

Program Outreach

- 37 Documentation of the availability of the School Breakfast Program (SBP) for participating LEAs. LEAs must inform households of the availability of the SBP at the beginning of the year and also send reminders about the SBP throughout the year. The reminders can be: written notices sent home, information included on the menu or postings on the district's website.
- 38 ___ All LEAs must inform eligible households about the availability and location of Summer Food Services Programs (SFSP) before the end of the school year. A list of sites which operate the SFSP is posted on the Department of Agriculture website annually.
