HARASSMENT, INTIMIDATION, AND BULLYING
NJDOE SCORE REPORT

Dear Parents/Guardians

For the past two years, our District has conscientiously implemented the requirements found in the Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act by adhering to reporting, investigation, counseling and remedial procedures to address and prevent incidents of Harassment, Intimidation, and Bullying (HIB) in our schools. In addition, education programs have been implemented in all of our schools and each school has an Anti-Bullying Specialist and a Safety Team.

In the spring of 2014, the New Jersey Department of Education analyzed the level of HIB Implementation in each school and assigned a score. The average score for all schools in Irvington represent the District score. The District score for the 2012 – 2013 school year is 60. The score for the 2013 – 2014 school year is 72. We are proud to announce that the score for each school improved when comparing the 2012 – 2013 and 2013 – 2014 school years.
