HARASSMENT, INTIMIDATION, AND BULLYING
NJDOE SCORE REPORT

Dear Parents,

For the past five years, our District has conscientiously implemented the requirements found in the Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act by adhering to reporting, investigation, counseling and remedial procedures to address and prevent incidents of Harassment, Intimidation, and Bullying (HIB) in our schools. In addition, education programs have been implemented in all of our schools and each school has an Anti-Bullying Specialist and a Safety Team.

In the spring of 2017, the New Jersey Department of Education analyzed the level of HIB Implementation in each school and assigned a score. The average score for all schools in Irvington represents the District score. The District score for the 2014 – 2015 school year is 76 and the score for the 2015 – 2016 school year is 75. We are proud to announce that the score for the 2016-2017 school year is 75. The total maximum score is 78.
