## Irvington Public Schools Summary of Assessment Information 2020-2021

- Number of Testing Administrations in Districts refers to the number of times a particular assessment will be offered during the school year.
- **Testing Mode** refers to how the student will be administered the assessment. The two modes are computer-based, and paper-and-pencil. Some computer-based assessments allow students to take the assessment using paper and pencil. Student's IEP will also determine the testing mode.
- **Testing Time** is the maximum amount of time allotted to students to complete the assessment. Most students finish well in advance of the allotted time.
- **Testing Window** is the period in which districts administer the statewide student assessment. It is not the actual number of days it takes a student to complete the assessment. Dates for test administrations will be posted on the District website. Parents can also inquire from their child's school.
- **Results Available** refers to date results are available to students/parents.
