Clarification of Heading Titles:

- **Number of Testing Administrations** - Times a particular assessment will be offered during the school year.
- **Testing Mode** - How students will be administered the assessment. The two modes are computer-based, and paper-and-pencil.
- **Testing Time** - Time allotted to students to complete the assessment.
- **Testing Window** - Period in which districts administer the statewide student assessment. It is not the actual number of days it takes a student to complete the assessment. Dates for test administrations will be posted on the District website. Parents can also inquire from their child's school.
- **Results Available** - Date results are available to parents/guardians/students/teachers/administration.
